Saturday September 13th

For the 14th straight year River Clean-Up Inc. along with the Hamilton County Solid Waste Board, the Town of Fishers and Cities of Noblesville and Carmel will coordinate a one-day cleaning of the White River in Hamilton County. This year we will be joined by other communities along the White River, so that on Saturday September 13th we will have a one day cleaning from Delaware County thru Marion County. Truly the largest single day of cleaning ever!.

This year's clean-up will be coordinated from 3 locations along the White River

- Moose Lodge – Located in Noblesville, off of Field Drive
- Renner's Automotive – Located between River Road and Allisonville Road on 146th Street.
- 116th Street Public Boat Launch – located on the northeast corner of 116th street and the White River Bridge.

Schedule of Events

(Snacks and Drinks will be provided during the day for participants)

- **9:00 am - Sign-in** - *It is assumed that your kids maybe coming and going throughout the day with Football and Soccer. Each unit will be required to have their kids sign in and out at your location.*
- **11:30am - 1:00pm - Lunch** will be served at each location
- **3:00pm - Final check-in** at your assigned location

Things to Bring:

Old Tennis Shoes, Shorts, Swim Suits, Gloves, Waterbottle/Canteen, Life Jackets (if you have), Change of Clothes, Rain Gear (Depending on the weather)

Camping will again be available to units that participate in this years clean-up at the White River Campgrounds located off Strawtown Road east of Cicero. On Saturday night we will again have a campfire program and flag retirement ceremony starting at 9:00.

Items of support that would help in this year's clean-up effort

- **Quad's and Trailer's** – To help with the removal and transportation along the river banks.
- **Shovel's, Rakes, etc..**
