# Lights Camera Action

This years camporee will consist of two different screen plays. Your troop will compete against other units to produce the Camp K Golden Globe Awards, and patrols will compete against each other to for the Independent Spirit Awards.

## Golden Globe Awards Competition:

- **Patch Design (5 bonus points)**
- **The Iron Chef of Del-Mi (25%),** The meal should include: Appetizer, Main Course, Vegetable, Starch, and Dessert. Scoring 1 to 5, Presentation, Taste, Use of Special Ingredients (to be provided). Each unit will have no more than 5 scouts and 2 adults an any time in the station during the competition.
- **Gateway (15%),** The adults of each unit will be responsible to build a gateway which effectively displays their units theme.
- **Campsite (15%),** The scouts will be responsible to continue the theme into the campsite.
- **Skit (20%),** Each unit will be responsible for at least one skit, sign up for skit will be during the PLC meeting on Friday night.
- **Scavenger Hunt (25%),** To encourage socializing between units we will have a Scavenger Hunt. This will not be your normal Scavenger Hunt. On Friday evening your SPL will be given a questionnaire which will include Units participating, Scouting History and Skills, District History and Camp K History.

## Independent Film Spirit Awards:

- **Top Gun, Orienteering and Signaling Skills**
- **Hoosiers, Snow Shoe Basketball (team work)**
- **Tomb Raider, Scout Skills and team work**
- **Transformer, Scout Skills and team work**
- **Star Wars, Accuracy**
- **The Highlander, team work and strength**

Note: The Independent Film Spirit competition will be open from 9:30 thru 4:00 for each patrol to complete. Each patrol should consist of 8 to 10 scouts. It will be the responsibility of each patrol leader to see that his patrol completes the tasks. Each unit will be asked to have 2 to 4 adults available to assist the station directors thru our the day.

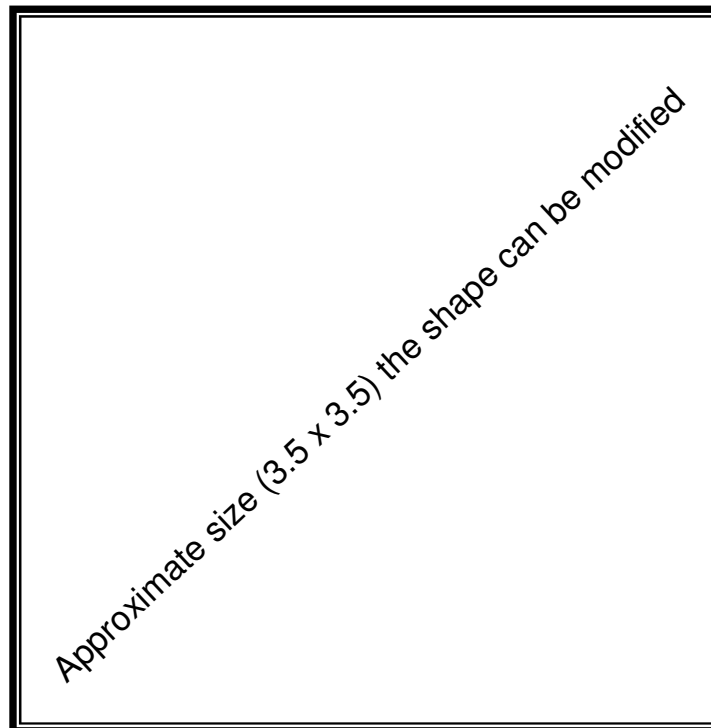
