Arrive at Camp K on Friday night anytime after 5:00 pm. The SPL and Scoutmaster meeting will be at 9:00 pm, and a coin toss will start the events at 8:45am Saturday.

Lunch will be prepared for all who attend and is included in the entry fee. Early entry fee is \$10 per person. All entries after January 13<sup>th</sup> will be \$12 per person.

**Special adult-only event** -- a Chili Cook-off for lunch on Saturday. Chili will be judged in hot, mild and unusual categories. Bring your best crock pot of chili (cheese, sour cream, crackers and antacid tablets will be provided)! Note: All cooking must be done in your campsite, and the chili will be brought to the Locker Room (Camp K dining hall).

The final weekend event is a Scout's Own service on Sunday morning at 9:00 with camp checkout immediately after.
